Course Content

This course would give you an understanding about enterprise architecture concept based on The Open Group Architecture Framework 10th Edition. The TOGAF Standard is developed and maintained by members of The Open Group, working within the Architecture Forum. This version builds on previous versions of the TOGAF Standard and updates the material available to architecture practitioners to assist them in building a sustainable Enterprise Architecture. Work on White Papers and Guides describing how to integrate and use this standard with other frameworks and architectural styles has highlighted the universal framework parts of the standard, as well as industry, architecture style, and purpose-specific tools, techniques, and guidance. This work is embodied in the TOGAF Library.
